

## Landscape Destroying Insects!

### *Japanese Beetles Our #1 Destroyer*

*"Skeletonized" leaves caused by Japanese beetle*

- The double threat to your lawn and landscape!
  - Immature white grub stage consumes grass roots in summer (August thru October)
  - Mature beetles consume a wide variety of tree and shrub foliage thru the rest of the growing season (Mid-June thru September)
- Adult beetles feed on foliage between the leaf veins, giving the leaves a lacy appearance
- Fruits and flowers can also be destroyed in a matter of days
- Struyk Turf's soil injected insecticide treatment done in the early spring or late fall can help prevent damage to your landscape

## *Bagworms*

- Bagworm caterpillars live in small bags constructed of silk and plant material
- Most common damage is done on Juniper, Red Cedar and Arborvitae, but they can also attack some deciduous trees
- Attacked plants can be partially defoliated and left unsightly
